

SCULPTURE BLOCK

Sculpture Canvas can be shaped with a saw, carving tools and rasps. It is much quicker and easier than traditional materials to create 3D or highly refined and detailed sculptures. Made from user-friendly materials. Can be glued, painted with tempera, acrylic or oil paints and can be coated with plaster or cement.

Create a KORU

You will need:

- Sculpture Block 15x15x2.5 cm
- Sculpture Carving Tools 6 Pce
- Sculpture Curved Rasp Size 1 Curved Flat
- Sculpture Curved Rasp Size 2 Flat Point
- Pencil
- Sandpaper (if desired)



Method:

Step 1:

Draw or trace a koru onto the surface of the Sculpture Block.



Step 2:

Using a V shaped carving tool from the set, carve along the lines around the outside of the koru.

Carve out enough to leave a deep groove.



Step 3:

Using the Flat Rasp and the Curved Rasp, start filing away the area outside the koru. Rasp the area down approx

10 mm below the koru ensuring the area is level all the way around.

Step 4:

Carve out the centre of the koru by following the lines using the V shape carving tool. Make sure the line is wide enough to fit the Curved Rasp with the flat end.



Step 5:

Using the Curved Rasp with the flat end, file out the inside curve of the koru.



Step 6:

Once you are happy with the depths of the recessing inside and outside the koru, use the Curved Rasp to "round" and smooth" all the edges around the koru.

Step 7:

Finally, use some fine sandpaper to sand around the entire surface to get a really smooth look.



Paint your koru if you like.
