

PRINTS ON COLOUR



With this creative artwork you'll learn to work with Star Tempera Poster Paint and Artists Printing Ink using lots of colour and powerful black patterns.

Learning Objectives:

Patterns, colour combination, hand eye coordination, fine motor skills, creative process.



You will need:

- Five Star Tempera Yellow, Orange, Brilliant Red
- Five Star Artists Printing Ink Black
- Five Star Printing Foam
- Foam Roller
- Five Star Lino Roller
- Pen/pencil
- Paper or Card
- Newspaper

You can use the patterned printing foams block many times – simply wash with water!



Lets Create:

Step 1:

Create a colourful background. For example put drops of Star Tempera brilliant red, yellow and orange on a piece of card and using the foam roller cover the entire sheet leaving a tonal effect and leave to dry.

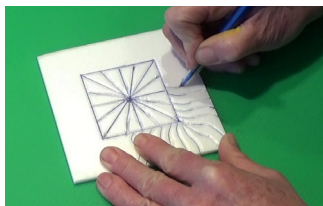


background and burnish with your hand – press down firmly and smooth over the entire surface. Then lift printing foam off carefully.



Step 2:

Take a sheet of Printing Foam and cut to the desired size for the print, then using a pen/pencil score the foam surface to create your pattern. Use a ruler for the straight lines and freehand for the curved lines.

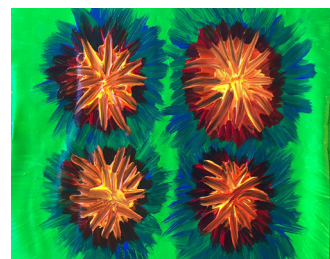


Step 6:

Repeat step 5 to make as many prints as you like.

Step 7:

Put aside to dry.



Alternative background using the same print.

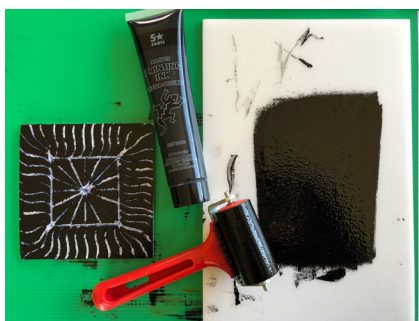
Step 3:

Using a spare sheet of printing foam (or a non porous surface) place a knob of black Artists Printing Ink onto it. Use the lino roller and roll out the ink until it is smooth and “sticky” and coats the roller evenly – always roll in a forward motion (not backwards and forwards).

Step 4:

Roll the black ink onto the patterned surface of the printing foam and coat evenly.



Step 5:

Place the inked pattern face down onto your painted

PAINTING WITH A BALLOON



This is a fun and unconventional way of painting which can produce some colourful and unique designs. Great for young artists and for the more experienced when medium are added to creative more complex artworks.

Learning Objectives:

Patterns, colour combination, hand eye coordination, fine motor skills, creative process.



You will need:

- Star Tempera Black, Yellow, Orange, Brilliant Red
- Canvas Panel or Card
- Balloon
- Containers/plates
- Newspaper

For older artists, add a "squirt" of Five Star Silicone Spray to give a different effect of "cells" forming in the colours.



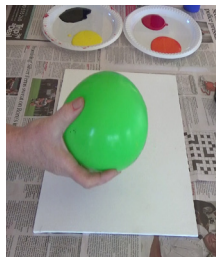
Lets Create:

Step 1:

Spread the newspaper out and place the canvas panel or card onto it.

Step 2:

Pour some of each of the Star Tempera colours onto a plate – several will fit if you use larger plates.



Step 3:

Blow up the balloon, but only to a small size as it is easier to handle and tie it off.



Step 4:

Dip the balloon in the first colour and dab onto the canvas panel or card. Continue to dip in the different colours and dab.

Step 5:

As you dab, you will see the colours mix so continue until you are happy with the effect. For the artwork shown, the coloured pattern runs through the middle and on the edges of the canvas panel.



Step 6:

Put aside to dry.



HINT: Use pre-painted backgrounds and Five Star Stencils with the balloon painting for something different to the conventional methods of painting.



Flowers & butterflies: Another idea, is to balloon paint an entire sheet as shown, then once dry, cut into shapes and stick onto a painted background.

PRINTING FOAM



Printing Foam is economical with a soft surface printing sheet of polystyrene. Printing foam is an easy to use printing block for water based based paints, water based printing inks and textile inks. The foam produces fine detailed lines and patterns that can be re-printed an unlimited number of times.

Create your own GIFT CARDS



You will need:

- Five Star Printing Foam A5
- Five Star Foam Rollers
- Five Star Star Tempera Metallic Paints
- White Card (A4 200-220g)
- Copy Paper (A4)
- HB pencil
- Five Star Creative Paints (optional)

Wrapping Paper can also be made using this technique. Requires an A3 sheet of cartridge paper.

Method - Gift Card:

Step 1:

Fold the white card in half and set aside.

Step 2:

Place the Printing Foam on onto a piece of A4 copy paper and draw around the outside with your pencil – this is so you know how to proportion your design.



Step 3:

Draw your design (for this example Christmas) inside the rectangle on the A4 copy paper. Please note: Words will need to be spelt backwards.

Step 4:

Place your A4 paper on top of the Printing Foam lining up the outside of the rectangle with your edges of the Printing Foam.

Step 5:

Trace over your design with the pencil pressing firmly to score the Printing Foam. Remove the paper. Ensure the indentation is quite deep – you may need go over the indented design lines again with your pencil to score the lines deeper to make a good print.

Step 6:

Pour out a little of 1 colour of Five Star Tempera Metallic paint on a piece of A4 copy paper.



Step 7:

Pour out a little of 1 colour of Five Star Tempera Metallic paint on a piece of A4 copy paper.

Step 8:

Place your painted design face down on the front in the centre of the folded card – press firmly all over and lift off.

Step 9:

Pour out a little of the next colour of Five Star Metallic Paint and roll it up with the other Foam Roller.

Step 10:

Roll down the outside edges of the front of the card leaving a gap out from your Christmas print design to form a border/frame.

Step 11:

Once dry, add “effects” with Five Star Creative Paint.



Method - Wrapping Paper:

Step 1:

Roller more paint onto your Printing Foam design then take a sheet of A3 paper and place your painted Printing Foam design face down, press firmly all over and lift off.

Step 2:

Repeat the previous 2 steps forming a pattern by aligning each print to cover the entire A3 page. Set aside to dry.

Step 3:

Once dry, add “effects” with Five Star Creative Paint.

STAR TEMPERA



This is a premium washable paint ideal for beginners and younger children. It is non toxic, water soluble and easy to clean up. Star Tempera Poster Paint comes in a range of vibrant colours including standards, fluorescents, glitters and metallics. The range of glitter and metallic colours give an extra brilliance to any art project. Ideal for posters, models and any art project.

Create a METALLIC ZEBRA



You will need:

- Five Star Star Tempera Metallic Paints
- Five Star Star Tempera Black Paint
- Five Star PVA Glue School Grade
- Five Star Glue Spreaders
- Five Star Painting Tray
- 1 sheet of A4 white card 200 g
- 1 sheet of A4 white card 400 g (or more)
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Newspaper



Alternatively this artwork can be created using Star Tempera Glitter Colours.

Method:

Step 1:

Place newspaper down to protect any surfaces.

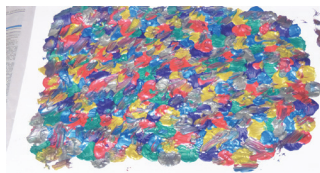
Step 2:

Pour each of the 6 Star Tempera Metallic colours into the painting tray and place a brush in each.



Step 3:

Using the 200 g piece of white card, start with 1 colour and "blob" dots on the page randomly, then select another colour and "blob" dots randomly. Continue in this manner until the entire page is filled and no white is showing. Then you can use a brush to gently brush across different colours so the colours start to merge slightly, if you like that effect. Set aside to dry.



Step 4:

Pour out a little of the Star Tempera Black in the clean paint tray and paint the heavier weight sheet of card. Finish using a crisscross pattern with the brush to give an "effect" pattern. Set aside to dry.



Step 5:

Turn over the painted metallic sheet and using a pencil draw



the outlines of the stripes you need to cut. Once you are happy with this start cutting the stripes to place onto the black background.



Step 6:

Lay all the stripes out in place. Pour some glue into the clean paint tray and using a glue spreader to glue each piece into place ensuring a gap is left between each of the metallic stripes. Set aside to dry.



Hint: Using this method, choose an easier design or something more complex.

WIZARD'S WAND



This is a creative and fun project, great for young adults olden enough to use a hot glue gun or as a project for parents to do together with younger children. Using metallic and glitter paints gives each wand a real sparkle!

Learning Objectives:

Imagination, hand eye coordination, creative process,



You will need:

- Wooden chopstick or piece of dowel
- Five Star NZACRYL Acrylic Metallic Colours
- Five Star Tempera Glitter Colours
- Five Star Artists Brushes
- Hot Glue Gun and Glue Sticks
- Marble or Gem
- Five Star PVA General Purpose Glue



Lets create:

Step 1:

Paint a base colour on your chopstick using your favourite Five Star Acrylic Paint metallic colour. Allow to dry.

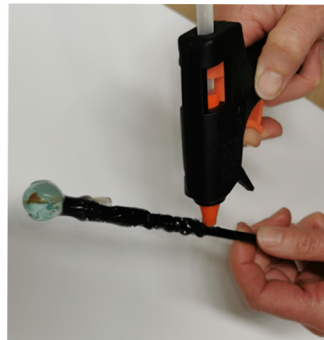
Step 2:

With a hot glue gun, glue your marble or gem to the top of the thicker end of the chopstick. Hold upright until set.



Step 3:

With the hot glue gun, carefully apply glue to your chopstick while rotating the chopstick in your hand. Be creative adding bumps and twist effects. It is best to hold the chopstick while drying at this stage, it won't take too long.



Step 4:

Once the glue is set, paint your glue covered chopstick with the same colour as your base. Or you may choose a contrasting colour.



Step 5:

When this is dry, add highlights in contrasting colour to the raised areas/bumpy bits.

Step 6:

Once the paint is completely dry, finish with a coat of Five Star PVA General Purpose Glue as a sealing coat. This will look white when wet but will dry clear.

Step 7:

Now you are ready to cast some spells!



CAUTION
Take care when using the hot glue gun - do not touch the glue until it has set
