Directions for use

- 1. Apply General Purpose Spotter neat to spot.
- 2. Agitate with a scraper, working from the outside in to keep the spot from spreading.
- 3. Allow to work for 5-10 minutes.
- 4. Blot with clean white towels to absorb stain.
- 5. Repeat if necessary.
- 6. Extract or rinse with water and blot dry. Before using on a carpet for the first time, test for colourfastness in an inconspicuous area.
