Directions:

Hard surface disinfectant: Dilute at ratio of 1:5 with water. Foam cleaning: Meter through Venturi/Foam unit at a breakdown of 1:50 with water depending on nature of foam required.

Manual cleaning: Use at a rate of 3-4ml/L of water, depending on the degree of soiling. Leave to act for 3-5 minutes for sanitising and rinse with potable water.

Safety Directions: Wear eye protection and protective gloves when mixing or using. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Ensure adequate ventilation when using.

MPI APPROVED C31: (All animal product except dairy) Before use, all edible product and packaging material must be removed from the room. After using this compound, food surfaces must be thoroughly rinsed with potable water before production starts.

Emergency Response: Contain spillage and absorb with mineral sponge or other inert absorbent.
