

6. Glass and Stainless Cleaner

Ultimo 6. Glass and Stainless Cleaner can be used as a spray cleaner for windows, glass partitions, mirrors and stainless steel, ceramic, porcelain chrome and painted surfaces.

Directions:

Use one dose from Ultimo Dispenser per bottle or bucket. Use a mop or spray on to surfaces to be cleaned. Rinse all food contacting surfaces with potable water after use.

MPI APPROVED C35 (All animal product except dairy). This may be used as a window cleaner for all areas. No edible product is permitted in the room during cleaning. Incidental contamination of food contact surfaces must be thoroughly cleaned, then rinsed with potable water.

Features and Benefits:
