

7. Multi Quat Sanitiser



Ultimo 7. Multi Quat Sanitiser is a chlorine free, non-perfumed, high performance quaternary based sanitiser. Can be used safely on all hard surfaces without the need of rinsing.

Directions:

Use one dose from Ultimo Dispenser per bottle or bucket. Use a mop or spray on to surfaces to be cleaned. Rinse all food contacting surfaces with potable water after use.

MPI APPROVED C43 (All animal product except dairy). In the case of operators that only process fish, food contact surfaces must be thoroughly drained to minimise residues and must not imply that it can be used as a non-rinse sanitiser by any other operators.

MPI Approved C 44

- 1. This may be used in all areas.
