Directions:

For use with the Ultimo Dispenser - Inject undiluted directly into wash water via the Ultimo automatic pump. Not recommended for manual dosing, unless in contingency commercial situations. Must be used in conjunction with ULTIMO VSCOS RINSE AID.

Features and Benefits:
