



## Instruction

For mechanical table clock with swiss type escapement

### 1. Unpacking the clock

Remove clock and winding key carefully from packing.

### 2. Start the clock

The timekeeping of the clock is 8 days. Do not forget to rewind the clock in time and constantly. Put the key on the winding arbor and turn clockwise until the movement is fully wound. (approx. 5 turns)

### 3. Setting the clock

Set the correct time by turning the minute hand clock- or counterclockwise.

### 4. Regulate the clock

This clock has been equipped by manufacturer with a precise 11-jewel escapement, it was in the production already carefully regulated. Should were be a readjustment required, this must be done with great care (Do not touch the spiral). Even a slight displacement of the lever arm of approximately 1 mm causes a change in speed of about 3-4 minutes / day:

Move to "+" = the clock is faster.

Move to „-“ = the clock is slow.

### 5. Service

For future Service please contact qualified clock or watchmaker. As a mechanical movement is affected by moisture, dust, heat and cold, we recommend to clean the movement after 5-8 years (depending on ambient conditions) by professional clock service. DO NOT lubricate the movement yourself, as it requires a special clock oil.
