
- May be subject to Australian Building Code Regulations for height and location fixing and may be subject to placement as per architectural drawings. In all cases, this is the responsibility of the installer.
- Slide the 2 brackets into the slot on the underside of the shelf.
- Locate position/height on wall and mark using fixing holes on wall brackets, ensuring unit is level.
- **3.** Drill holes and loosely secure unit to wall surface using screws and wall plugs provided.
- **4.** Check the shelf is level and tighten screws to finish installation.


Operation
