CHLOR BRITE

(NZFSA APPROVED C33) LIQUID BLEACH

CHLOR BRITE is a convenient liquid bleach - sodium hypochlorite, which can be used for CLEANING, WHITENING, REMOVING STAINS, DISINFECTING AND DEODORISING. In the LAUNDRY or for BUILDING MAINTENANCE, CHLOR BRITE will be found just right. Multi-purpose and very efficient, you can rely on CHLOR BRITE.

LAUNDRY

Use **CHLOR BRITE** for whitening whites, brightening colour-fast fabrics and disinfecting all the wash.

HOUSEHOLD MACHINES

Top Loading
1 cup CHLOR BRITE per load
Front Loading
1/2 cup CHLOR BRITE per load
Twin Tub
1/2 cup CHLOR BRITE per load

COMMERCIAL MACHINES

50-60ml (1/4 cup) **CHLOR BRITE** per 10 litres of water.

STAIN REMOVAL

Normal stains come out in the wash when using **CHLOR BRITE** as directed. For stubborn stains including ink, egg, milk, coffee, tea, chocolate, wine, blood, scorch, grass, fruit, vegetable, collar dirt and mildew, wash the articles in cold water, then soak in a solution of 1/2 cup **CHLOR BRITE** per 2 litres of cold water for 5 minutes. Rinse well and repeat soaking if necessary.

COLOUR-FAST TEST

Most modern fabrics are colour-fast. If in doubt mix 1/3 cup **CHLOR BRITE** with 2/3 cup of water, then test one drop of this solution on an inconspicuous portion of the fabric. Make sure drop penetrates, let stand 2 minutes and blot dry.

Kitchen: CHLOR BRITE is recommended for removing stubborn stains, disinfecting and deodorising of clean surfaces. Use on **BENCHES**, **DRAINS**, **CUTTING BOARDS**, **DISHMOPS**, **STOVES**, **REFRIGERATORS**, **DISH-WASHERS**, **CROCKERY**, **GLASSWARE** and **PLASTICWARE**. Wash clean first, then wipe with a cloth dipped in a solution of 1/4 cup **CHLOR BRITE** per 1 litre of warm water. Leave the surface wet for 5 minutes and wipe dry with a clean cloth. Wash hands immediately after use. Kitchenware articles that are small enough for soaking are best treated by making up a bath using 1/4 cup of bleach to 2 litres of water. Allow articles to soak for up to 15 minutes; rinse and dry.

Bathroom: shower recess, baths, basins, tiles, grouting, floors, mildew, brushes, combs, etc., use 1/4 cup bleach per 1 litre of warm water.

Around the Building: Painted or unpainted woodwork, linoleum, plastic garbage cans, open drains, concrete stains Wash then wipe with a cloth dipped in a solution of 1/4 cup **CHLOR BRITE** per 1 litre of warm water. Leave the surface wet for 5 minutes and wipe dry with a clean cloth. Wash hands immediately after use.

Toilets: Use **CHLOR BRITE** to remove stains, disinfect and deodorise both in the bowl and on the toilet seat. Clean, flush and pour 1/2 cup **CHLOR BRITE** into the bowl and swirl around. Let the solution stand for up to 10 minutes, then flush. **CHLOR BRITE** is safe in septic systems. Wash toilet seat with cloth or sponge soaked in 1/2 cup **CHLOR BRITE** mixed with 1 litre of water.

SPECIAL NOTE

DO NOT USE AMMONIA OR ACID BASED TOILET BOWL CLEANERS WITH CHLOR BRITE. Do not use on silk, wool, leather, everglaze, rayon, acetate, drip dry and non-iron cottons. Do not use on aluminium, chipped or worn enamel, silver, steel or any unpainted metal surface. Dilute **CHLOR BRITE** with water before immersing any articles. Do not use undiluted at any time. Store in a cool place.
