Secor® Wireless Dual Press Panic Button WEB300

### General

This Wireless Dual Press Panic system consists of a transmitter WEB300 and receiver RRR1000W. WEB300 is designed to report and set alarm when the dual buttons are pressed. The transmitter is fully supervised for tamper, low battery and RF fail. Receiver RRR1000W has 4 relay outputs which can be connected to an alarm panel.


#### Operation

Once alarm, tamper, RF fail, or low battery occurs, the receiver beeps and the user number and problem will be shown on the 4-digit display. In the meantime, the signal of ALRM will be sent to the alarm panel via relay output 1. TAMPER 2, LOW BATTERY 3, and RF FAIL 4. The beep can be reset by the Alarm Reset button mounted on top of the receiver. After 3 minutes, if the problem is not rectified, the beep will resume and it beeps every minute. In the meantime, the display will show the user number and problem.

# Receiver RRR1000W layout

## 4-digit display:

The first digit shows the status of operation and the other three the user number.

# How to ADD (register) o transmitter (user) to the receiver:

- Enter the user number by pressing button "T" tens and "O" ones
- Press button "ADD"; letter A shows up
- Press the panic or tamper switch in the transmitter to register; letter A flashes three times done
- The user number is automatically increased by one -ready for the next register
- To exit ADD mode before the 15-second timeout expires, press ADD button again

## How to delete o transmitter or delete all:

- To delete a single transmitter: enter the user number you wish to delete, and press butt should flash once and the ID number on the display will be increased by 1 – ready to del
- To delete all: press button DEL and hold for 5s till dALL appears on the display

#### How to review past ten events:

Press and hold button "H" for 3s

## How to display total number of transmitter registered

Press and hold button "O" for 3s. Total number learned users will be shown on the display

## Relay outputs

The receiver has 4 relay outputs and each one has contacts of NO, NC and Com

Relay 1

Alarm

Relay 2 Relay 3 Tamper Low battery

Relay 4

RF fail

# How to turn off the beep

To mute the audible beep, press and hold button T(tens) for 3 seconds till you hear a beep. To rehold button T(tens) again till you hear 3 beeps.
