### **Product Description/Indication**

Adhesive for Kettenbach addition-curing impression and reline impression materials. Adheres to metals and acrylics.

#### Instructions for use

Apply a <a href="https://dhesive.onto">https://dhesive.onto</a> the impression tray and allow it to dry for approx. 5 minutes. Warmth and compressed air curtail the drying time. When using plastic impression trays, please check that they are compatible with the adhesive. Replace the cap on the bottle immediately after use!

After mixing the impression material, load it into the tray within 30 minutes.

Remains of impression material can be cleaned off the tray with cleaning solvent, petroleum ether or orange oil.

#### Warnings

Do not use Panasil® Adhesive with condensation-curing silicones, polyether or polysulfide materials.

### Precautions

Do not use after the expiration date.

Do not swallow the material! If accidentally swallowed: consult a doctor if problems arise or persist.
