DIRECTIONS:

Before beginning application, make sure the surface is cool and dry. Shake product well. Apply to a clean cloth or applicator pad. Cover one section at a time with a smooth even coat. Allow to dry and wipe off with a clean cloth. Always use sparingly for best results
