DESCRIPTION:

Spray Booth Coating is a protection for paint spray booths. It is a clear washable booth coating that is easy to apply, fast drying and economical. It can be washed off with water. To adequately treat most spray booths, 2 x 4ltr is sufficient.

DIRECTIONS:

Apply using a conventional spray gun with the pressure set at approximately 275 kPa (40 PSI). Apply 2 coats allowing the film to touch dry between coats. Apply in a uniform fashion with overlapping passes to ensure complete coverage of the surface.

To remove, wash off with water using a sponge or hose. Scrubbing with a brush may be necessary if there is excessive build up of overspray.
