

# **TASK FORCE POWDER**

# PRODUCT INFORMATION SHEET

#### **DESCRIPTION:**

**Task Force** Carpet Cleaner is a unique deep clean combination of water soluble solvents, alkaline salts and top grade surfactants, leaving a fresh smelling carpet free of dirt and grease. Task Force is a powdered, low foam formulation designed for use through portable and truck mount hot water extraction equipment. Economical dilution to 1:120. **Task Force** Carpet Cleaning Powder is a unique combination of soil removal and suspension agents formulated in conjunction with top grade surfactants. It is designed to provide very gentle cleaning action and freshening that leaves carpets, rugs and upholstery de-odorised and free of grease and dirt. It should only be used with steam or hot water extraction units or wet vacuum units. Task Force exhibits a low foam profile and moderately alkaline pH.

### **USE:**

For industrial use only. DO NOT SWALLOW. Remove furniture as necessary. Dry vacuum. Pre-treat badly stained spots by pre-spraying with a solution of 10 grams of Task Force Carpet Cleaning Powder per litre of water. Prepare a 'Use Solution' by adding 40 grams of powder per litre of water. Mix until all powder is dissolved. Heavy soil on carpet may require 80 grams of powder per litre of water. Corners should be scrubbed with a hand brush dipped in 10 grams per litre of water. Pour 'Use Solution' into tank and proceed to steam clean carpets followed by vacuuming. Allow carpet to dry (typically 1 – 4 hours depending on pile height, humidity and air flow). Once dry, vacuum carpet to pick up soil and reset pile. Allow carpet to dry thoroughly before replacing furniture. Wash all equipment with warm water and allow to dry before storage.

# **SAFETY:**

First Aid:
