
WARNING: DO NOT USE THIS PRODUCT ON A VEHICLE THAT IS INDICATED AS "NO-FIT".

The Yakima Fit-List now includes approved SkyPeak HD™ fits for many popular vehicles. Updates and additions to the Yakima Fit-List for rooftop tents are being made continually. Please go to fitlookup.yakima.com for latest updates.

Vehicles that we have seen and tested are designated as "FIT" or "NO-FIT" for SkyPeak HD. Fits for SkyPeak HD are different than for other Yakima products. Please note that virtually all factory crossbars are too flexible for rooftop tents. So vehicles approved in the Fit-List will still require a Yakima roof-rack system. If we have not tested your particular vehicle and rack system, you can use the checklist below to evaluate whether your vehicle and rack system may support a SkyPeak HD.

Remember, the checklist below is designed to be a guideline only and any installation not on our approved Fit-List is at the sole risk and responsibility of the owner or installer.

- ☐ The vehicle and rack system have a minimum load carrying capacity of
- ☐ For factory-tracks or fixed-points (see figure 1), ensure that the roof does not deform when heavy loads are applied.
- ☐ For vehicles with raised-rails, position the crossbars as close as possible to
- Ensure that the crossbar spread is between 30" 68" (76 172 cm).
- Do not use with factory-crossbars, they are too flexible.
- Do not position the mounting hardware more than 1" outside of the Tower (see figure 2).










ASSEMBLE AND INSTALL

REMOVE THE CONTENTS FROM THE TENT.










- A. Using a key, dislodge the black plastic plug from the latches.
- B. Insert a key into the lock core, and insert the lock core into the latch. Rotate the as necessary until the lock core fully seats.
- C. Remove the key. Repeat for the other latch.






NOTE: Be mindful of antennas or other potential contact points on the vehicle's roof.

PLACE THE TENT ON YOUR CROSSBARS.

Have at least three additional people assist you in lifting the SkyPeak™ onto your vehicle's crossbars.


7 INSTALL THE CROSSBAR CLAMPS.

Install the Rear Crossbar Clamps:




NOTE: If you purchased an extra set of clamps for a third crossbar, install them along with the clamps included in this kit.


- From the hinge side of the tent, install an adjustable clamp followed by a sliding clamp on each track, positioning them as shown.
- Lift the tent off the front crossbar and slide all clamps past it toward the middle of the tent.
- Then, lift the tent off the rear crossbar and move the adjustable clamps on each track past the rear crossbar to the end of the tracks.



Install the Front Crossbar Clamps:





- From the hinge side of the tent, install a sliding clamp followed by an adjustable clamp on each track, positioning them as shown.
- Lift the tent off the front crossbar and slide the sliding clamp on each track past it.





SECURE CROSSBAR CLAMPS


- A. With the tent properly positioned on the vehicle, slide all clamps until they contact the crossbars. Using a 4 mm wrench, tighten each clamp knob as shown. Fully tighten to 3.5 Nm (2.6 lb-ft).
- B. Insert the clamp rod through both halves of the clamp, hand-tightening until both halves make firm contact with the crossbar.
- C. Then, use a torque wrench to fully tighten to 3.5 Nm (2.6 lb-ft).
- D. Attach a lock to a clamp rod on both the front and rear crossbars, then secure them as shown.
- E. Finally, using the 4 mm wrench, install the four end caps using two M4 x 6 plastite screws each. Fully tighten to 1 Nm (0.7 lb-ft).











NOTE: After 12 hours of initial use, retighten the clamp rod.

NOTE: On certain vehicles, reversing the positions of the front and rear clamps may improve access to the clamp bolt.
