







Quill Size: Queen Size 76" x 76" (1.94m x 1.94m)

I am so thrilled to be releasing my second range of fabric, that I couldn't help but design two quilts using the full range! I hope you like this simple and quick to put together quilt as I do.

Cutting Instructions

- Using the templates on page 6, cut your centre pieces
- Border 1 & 2
 - $4 \times 5^{-1}/2$ " x $5^{-1}/2$ " squares in Nimiane Green
 - $4 \times 5^{1/2}$ " x $16^{1/2}$ " rectangles in Eleri
 - 2 strips of 2 ³/₄" x 40" in Fae Green and 2 strips of the same size in Fae Yellow
- Using the templates on page 6 cut
 - 16 triangles in Ettare Blue
 - 40 triangles in Caelia Yellow
- Cut 140 squares at 5.7/8" x 5.7/8" using all the fabrics from the range


Construction Instructions

Step 1

Hand sew the centre block together using the diagrams below for guidance.



Step 1 - cont.



Step 2 - Border 1 and 2

Using the machine, sew one of your squares in Nimiane Green to each side of one of the rectangles of Eleri: do this twice. Then sew on to your centre block.




Sew on the strips of Fae Yellow to the top and bottom of the centre block, then the strips of Faw Green to the left and right. Mitre the corners.

Your centre block should now measure 40" x 40"



Step 3

Sew the squares together to create rows, then sew the rows together. Use the diagram below to help with the order and sections required for final construction.




Step 4
Baste and bind as desired.

Final Quilt Layout







Requirements

Quilt Size: 76" x 76" (1.94m x 1.94m)

- > 25cm of:
 - > Ettare Blue DV7140
 - > Fae Green DV7154
 - > Fae Yellow DV7153
- > 30cm of Eleri DV7132
- > 1m of Caelia Yellow DV7138
- > 3.5m total of the rest of the range for the centre block and squares. A fat 1/4 bundle will be ideal.
- > 60cm for binding of your choice
